

Prohibited Items at the C. M. Hinton, Jr. Regional Landfill

The landfill cannot accept:

- Liquids
- Motor-driven vehicles
- Fuel tanks, used oil filters or other devices that use to contain petroleum-based compounds such as gasoline, fuel oil, hydraulic fluid, lubricants, or other chemicals
- Debris from non-hazardous chemical spills
- Friable asbestos
- Sandblast grit and non-liquid paint wastes
- Infectious or hospital waste
- High-pH and low-pH materials
- Spent filter media residue
- Hazardous waste
- Lead acid batteries
- Pesticides or other home use chemicals
- Items containing chlorofluorocarbons (CFCs)
- Tires
- Commercial loads of electronics, including televisions, office machines and computer equipment
- Large appliances such as ovens, dishwashers, refrigerators, air conditioners, etc.
